## From the Congregation President...

In the month of November we will be having Pastor Bob Moberg, Pastor Derek, and Pastor Bruce leading our Sunday services (I'm still working on scheduling the fifth Sunday). I'm working on the schedule for December and will soon start working on the plans for January as the pastors do get requests to lead services pretty far in advance. Pastor Rick has graciously agreed to lead our Christmas Eve service (I was finding that the group of pastors we have been using were not available due to family plans for Christmas). I will let Pastor Rick know that we'd be happy to have folks from Spring Prairie join us for the service at 4:00 if the earlier time works better for them and if our service is too early for any of you, Spring Prairie's Christmas Eve service is at 6:00.

I have received communications from Marie (from the synod staff) and the group of pastors from the area ELCA congregations regarding continuing to explore ways in which we may work cooperatively. It is too soon to know, but there could be the possibility of some type of sharing of pastors between congregations. We are not the only congregation that could be looking for a pastor who is part time. As the Council has discussed financial considerations related to our search for a pastor, one of the benefits we've identified from sharing a pastor with another church is the potential of a large saving on health insurance benefits. If we were to find a pastor for our congregation on a part time basis, we could need to pay the full cost of health insurance (a very large expense) while if we "split" a pastor with another church, the health insurance cost would also be split. If we had a half-time pastor getting health insurance through us, it would be a financial challenge (Pastor Jason didn't need to get health insurance through us which was a large savings).

As I'm writing this paragraph on Halloween, last night I was able to participate in a Zoom meeting with the pastors from the other 4 area ELCA churches who have been meeting and an in-person meeting is being planned for the evening of December 1st to be hosted at our church. This will involve the pastors and 2 members from each of the congregations along with staff from the synod to continue exploring ways that we can work together. The intent is to have the 5 churches continue to communicate in the months ahead. Pastor Jason had been meeting for a year or so with the other pastors so this is a continuation of an ongoing conversation.

## October Church Council Meeting Highlights

Paul reported that offerings received so far this year are below projections, but our expenses have also been lower since Pastor Jason left and we've had substitute pastors. Expenses have been roughly \$5,500 over receipts, but we have funds to cover this shortfall. Paul has gotten a price for snow removal from the company that we used last year and the Council approved of having them do snow removal again this winter. We are planning to have Christmas Eve, but not a Christmas Day service this year. (While we liked having both the last couple years, for the sake of practicality when trying to find pastors to lead Christmas services, returning to what had been our practice for some time of not having a service on Christmas Day this year makes sense.) The Council talked about the possibility of locking the doors about 5 minutes after the start of services as a security precaution.

The Council will be meeting again November 18th at 5:00.
